

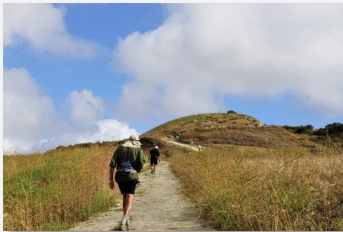

## ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP in OLLI at University of California, Irvine

Osher Lifelong Learning Institute (OLLI) at UCI is pleased to offer a special **Associate Membership** to recent emeriti/retirees from the University of California – Irvine. To qualify for this membership, you need to be a UCI employee (professor, doctor, staff, etc.) who has retired in calendar year 2017, January 1st through September 2017. The special reduced fee for Associate Membership will be **\$25** (instead of the **regular fee of \$150**) for the **Fall 2017** semester only. This will allow Associate Members to register beginning on September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017 and will be effective for the Fall 2017 semester only. Associate Members will have all the rights and privileges of regular membership, i.e. access to at least 6 courses and unlimited special events. **Registration must be done by phone to qualify for this reduced rate.**
