### We ALWAYS knew UCI Retirees Rock!

Remember that CUCRA\* survey we asked you to fill out several months ago? Well the results are in!

This UC system-wide survey resulted in responses from nearly 5,000 UC retirees, including over 500 UCI respondents.

UCI responses note that our retirees have continued a growing trend in volunteering (teaching, writing and consulting) while others have taken on new jobs and businesses. Also clear from the results is the fact that an impressive number continue to be an integral part of their own as well as the UCI community by contributing both their time and financial support.

We will highlight some key points in a follow-up document, but here are a few:

70% volunteer for community/civic organizations, faith-based groups, political causes

45% volunteer for UCI as mentors, teachers, advisers, fundraisers, committees & programs

19% have taken on another paid position in retirement: 9% at UCI

**40%** provide professional services

**18%** have authored written work (non-fiction, autobiographies, poetry and fiction)

15% have received awards or recognitions

57% provide care for another person

**58%** are engaged in staying physically fit

54% are members of UCI's Retirees Association
