The UCI Center for Emeriti and Retirees (CER) is the official connection between retired UCI faculty and staff, their respective associations, the local community and the university. It is the administrative organization over the UCI Retirees Association (UCIRA) and the UCI Emeriti Association (UCIEA). The CER offers many programs related to retiree benefits, health and other general topics, as well as services such as continuing UCI email. Our director also has negotiated the discounts (parking, bookstore, etc.) we enjoy.

The Retirees Association (UCIRA) has a different focus. We look to provide fun, social and educational activities for all. This has included lectures, cooking classes, hikes, bus tours, and two ever-popular annual events: the Art Show and the Anne Paden Golf tournament. The newsletter, emailed at the start of each month, keeps you up-to-date on our offerings, and of course, information is always available on the website. We trust that you will find something that intrigues you.

Equally important, the UCIRA provides representation on UC system-wide committees <u>regarding all continuing UC retiree benefits</u>. The UCIRA does this primarily through our participation in our UC system-wide organization, the Council of UC Retirees Association (CUCRA). CUCRA advocates on behalf of all UC retirees, interacting with the UC Office of the President regarding health insurance and other retirement benefits, and with the Retirement Administration Service Center on the type and quality of services provided to retirees.

Your dues: where they go and why they are important?

Your dues help support a variety of programs. Events such as bus tours and the golf tournament have a participant fee to off-set the costs, but we usually absorb administrative costs. We limit printing and mailing costs by trying to increase email communication; however, we do send periodic updates and invitations by regular mail to include our colleagues without computers. The UCIRA is also a regular contributor to the Staff Assembly Scholarship program, which supports staff in their efforts to continue their education. A portion of your dues also helps support UCI's representation in CUCRA. Finally, for many events, UCIRA members receive priority registration, discount fees and/or complimentary parking.

Events are open to retirees even if not members of the Association. However, we hope you will join to keep the wide variety of programs and activities going.
